

DAIRY PROJECTS

Dairy Project animals must be in member's possession by June 1st.

Dairy projects may be repeated. Members MUST indicate on their enrollment form the number of years in the project (include the current year). **EXAMPLE:** John has taken a dairy project for 6 years + this year = 7 years.

Department #400-Junior Fair Dairy Exhibitor Rules & Regulations

A. Show Rules

1. Show halters must be used.
 2. No cattle with horns will be allowed in any classes
 3. Exhibitor show apparel shall be:
 - White or colored collared shirt without lettering or farm name.
 - White, black or blue jeans/slacks. Shorts and bibs are prohibited.
 - Hard soled shoes or boots only. Tennis shoes and sandals prohibited.
- *Proper Jr. Fair show attire must be worn at Junior Fair Livestock sale.

B. All Dairy Projects

4. All Dairy projects must be in the Junior Fair exhibitor's possession by June 1 of current year.
2. Dairy projects must be entered in Junior Fair for exhibition/competition. Entry deadline is June 15th.
3. Exhibitor must provide own storage for feed and equipment.
4. Dairy Project Exhibit entries
 - Calf and Heifer project exhibitors may make one entry per class 400-A, 400-B, 400-C, 400-D, 400-E, 400-F, 400-G
 - *Cow and Production project exhibitors may make one entry in two classes from class 400-H, 400-I, 400-J (entries must be in different classes)

C. Department 400-Junior Fair Dairy Classes

- 400-A Junior Heifer Calf (Born March 1st - April 30th of 2021)
- 400-B Intermediate Heifer Calf (Born December 1st, 2020-February 28th of 2021)
- 400-C Senior Heifer Calf (Born September 1st, 2020-November 30th, 2020)
- 400-D Summer Heifer Yearling (Born June 1st-August 31st, 2020)
- 400-E Junior Heifer Yearling (Born March 1st -May 31st, 2020)
- 400-F Intermediate Heifer Yearling (Born December 1st, 2019-February 28th of 2020)
- 400-G Senior Heifer Yearling (Born Sept 1st, 2019- November 30th, 2019)
- 400-H 2-Year Old Cow (Born Sept 1st, 2018-August 31st, 2019)
- 400-I 3-4 Year old Cow (Born September 1st, 2018- August 31st, 2018)
- 400-J Aged cow (Born before September 1st 2018)

B. Awards & Premiums

- *Showmanship Classes - Classes - Grand & Reserve Grand Champions (Each breed)- Overall Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion- Supreme Female Overall
- *One gallon of milk from the Grand Champion Cow will be auctioned at the Junior Fair Livestock Sale. The proceeds of the auction will be equally divided among members participating in the Junior Fair Dairy Show.
- *Members who also carry a market livestock project/s must sell their market project rather than the gallon of milk.
- *Premiums: \$8.00 per entry exhibited that receives a Superior or Outstanding; \$4.00 per entry exhibited that receives a Good rating.
