- b. A write up of 75 words or less about yourself (include name, school, grade, parents activities, club name, etc.) for coronation activities and the Fair Parade. (if we do not have this write up, your name, club/organization and parents announced only) These write-ups will be edited into a shorter version to comply with parade regulations.
- c. Signatures of the applicant as well as the parent/guardian and dated.
