

# Getting Wild at Henry County 4-H Camp

4-H Camp Palmer

I hope all of you are excited to join us at Henry County 4-H Camp this year!

You will get to know the outdoors because it is where you spend most of your time. You will learn to get along with others and compete in various activities with team members of your assigned group. Swimming will be offered at various times during the day along with plenty of other fun and exciting activities for you to enjoy. All camp activities are held in various facilities including the Craft pavilion, Nature center, multi-purpose Recreation Hall, Adirondack Shelter and Dining Hall. Recreational activities take place on the sports field, volleyball court, basketball court, miniature golf course, archery range, swimming pool and Harrison Lake (canoeing). We have a human foos ball game, Ga-Ga Pit, and Square in the Air for all to enjoy.

Travel groups are named by the counselors and each camper is assigned to a group. Part of the camp experience is to meet new friends and get to know others from all areas of the county.

## CHECK IN PROCESS:

**Check in will begin at 3:00pm AT THE COVERED BRIDGE. Please DO NOT ARRIVE SOONER THAN YOUR ASSIGNED TIME SLOT.** This is a CURB-SIDE DROP OFF (same concept as last year), if your child has medications for the nurse, you will see the nurse to register the medications. Each camper will receive a printed schedule of the week's activities as well as their Cabin Assignment & Group Assignment. Name tags are given at check-in and campers will be required to wear the name tag throughout camp. Counselors will help your child find their cabin and transport their luggage!

## CHECK OUT PROCESS:

Check out will be held on Sunday **June 26**. Campers will bring all their luggage from the cabins to the Parking Lot in front of the Office (If it's raining, luggage will be in the lodge). Pick up will begin at 9:30am and will be sorted based on last name. If your child/ren are NOT to leave camp on Sunday morning or at any other time with anyone other than you, please be sure to remind the office. **Dismissal times as follows:**

9:50-10:10am—LAST NAME G-N

110-10:30pm—LAST NAME A-F

## CAMP STORE:

4-H Camp Palmer has some extras of their own offered at the camp store. The store has t-shirts, hats, sweatshirts, backpacks, novelty items, souvenirs, candy bars and frozen snacks. Items range from \$1—\$35.

**NEW IN 2022: CAMPERS BRINGING MONEY TO CAMP WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN MONEY.**

**THERE WILL NOT BE A STAFF MEMBER MONITORING CAMPER "BANKS."** The 4-H Camp Palmer Store will be open during open recreation time, as campers arrive to camp on Wednesday and as campers depart from camp on Sunday. Attached in this packet are some of the items available for purchase at the store.

### **WHAT SHOULD I BRING TO CAMP?**

#### **But first! – What NOT to bring:**

- × Weapons (includes knives of any kind)
- × Drugs INCLUDES Vape Pens
- × Alcohol
- × Fireworks
- × Cell phones (no exceptions)

#### **Otherwise... Here's your checklist!**

Bedding: (sheets, blanket, pillow, sleeping bag)

- Twin-sized sheets (fitted sheets are convenient for the mattresses)
- Sleeping Bag (goes on top of your sheets)
- Pillow
- 2 towels
- 1-2 washcloths
- 1 beach towel
- Comfortable clothes (not new)
- Sweatshirt or jacket
- Rain poncho or raincoat
- Clothing or costumes to fit the themes (included in this packet)
- Bathing suit (even if you are not swimming – it's for the showers)
- Two pairs of shoes (again, not new)
- Shower shoes (croc's or flops)
- Flashlight (with batteries)
- Personal hygiene items (soap, shampoo, toothbrush/paste, deodorant, etc.)
- Bug spray
- Sunscreen
- Laundry bag (to store your dirty clothes in!)

#### ***Optional items:***

- Spending money for the camp store (packet includes some items being sold this year)
- Camera (PLEASE mark with camper's name)
- Rug/mat for floor by bunk
- Snacks (MUST be sealed in an air-tight container, no exceptions)
- Watershoes/high boots (cannot use flip-flops for this activity)

Please be sure to review the 4-H Camp Palmer Guidelines and communicate them to your children.

**DO NOT BRING CELL PHONES, DRUGS, ALCOHOL, VAPE PENS, FIREWORKS OR KNIVES/WEAPONS!**

**Henry County 4-H Camp Guidelines**

1. Campers are not permitted to leave camp at any time without the consent of the Henry County 4-H Camp Director, parent or legal guardian or camp nurse. If leaving with a parent upon request, please check out and upon returning check-in with the Camp Nurse or Camp Director.
2. The bell is to be used to signal group changes and the P.A. for emergency purposes. The Adult Staff and counselors have authorization to use these devices only.
3. The following areas and equipment are to be used only with staff supervision or during assigned times:
  - a. Pool
  - b. Wetlands, streams and lake
  - c. Canoes
  - d. Nature Center
  - e. Shooting Sports range
  - f. High ropes
  - g. zip-line
4. Dining Hall etiquette:
  - \*Campers will wash or sanitize their hands before each meal. Campers select a table to sit at for the duration of camp for all meals. Campers may be excused from the meal table by a counselor, camp director or nurse.
  - \*Proper attire is to be worn at all meals. Hats need to be taken off upon entering the dining hall. Campers wearing swimsuits to meals should wear shorts and a shirt over them. Theme dress is encouraged for meals and activities.
5. Cabin etiquette:
  - \*Campers are expected to respect individual's property. This includes not being in anyone's belongings without permission.
  - \*Girl campers are to be in girl's cabins and area; boys in boy's cabins and area.
  - \*Cabin inspection will be anytime from 9:00-11:45 a.m. daily. Campers are responsible for cleaning areas around the cabins, buildings and trash receptacles. Clean cabins will be selected each day for boys and girls. Dirty cabins will also be selected each day.
  - \*When it is time for lights out- lights are to be off, flashlights off and campers in their bunks.
6. Campers are not permitted to bring personal sports equipment with them to camp.
7. Other Expectations:
  - A. Campers should always be with their assigned groups during group activities (unless with the camp nurse or director).
  - B. All injuries or illnesses need to be reported to the camp nurse. The camp nurse will be the only person to dispense medicine to campers.
  - C. NO drugs, alcohol, fireworks or cell phones are allowed at camp. **Cell phones confiscated will be kept by the camp director until the end of camp.**
  - D. NO profanity.
  - E. Shoes must be worn at all times.
  - F. NO vehicles permitted on the camp.
  - G. NO visitors are permitted without permission of the Camp Director. Visitations should be arranged ahead of time.
  - H. NO cell phones—Ohio 4-H Policy
8. All campers, counselors and county staff are expected to assist in camp clean up daily and the final day of camp. Lastly, any individual found doing damage to any area of the camp facilities, especially recreational equipment and within the cabins, will be disciplined by the Camp Director. The camper/s will be charged the cost of replacement or repairs. Parents will be notified immediately of such activity.

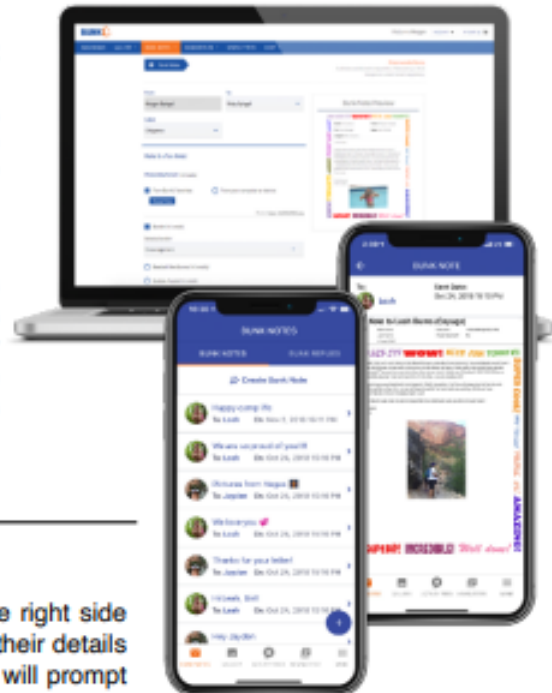

You will be prompted to select a bundle for access to your Parent Portal. Bundles include credits for you to send Bunk Notes and enhance your notes with borders, photos, sports scores, and puzzles. You can select a bundle based on your needs and how often you want to communicate with your camper.

### SENDING BUNK NOTES

**Send Bunk Notes** day or night! Your camp receives a pdf at **3:00 am EST** each day containing all Bunk Notes received in the last 24 hours. Camp prints each Bunk Note and delivers them to your camper with the regular mail. You can purchase more credits anytime in the Bunk Notes menu. Successfully sent Bunk Notes will appear under Bunk Notes > View Sent.

**Bunk Notes for Families:** Purchase **Bunk Notes Express** and receive a unique email address for your camper. Edit this email address under the Bunk Notes tab. Anyone in your family can directly email your camper at this address, and the note will be delivered as a regular Bunk Note. A credit is deducted from your account for each note. These notes can also be confirmed as sent under Bunk Notes > View Sent.



### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

**Can other relatives use these services?** Absolutely! On the right side of the dashboard, you'll select **Invite Family Members**, enter their details and they will be sent an email invitation. **PLEASE NOTE** this will prompt them to set up their own account. It does not provide them access to your account, bundle, OR your Bunk Note Credits.
